09-043 Resolution to Approve Agreements/Contracts that Benefit the Students of the Mansfield City Schools District

Mr. Rusiska moved and Mr. Danza seconded a resolution to approve the following contract that will directly benefit Mansfield City Schools' students:

- Agreement with Wright's Limousine Service to provide transportation for a Special Education student to attend the Ohio State School for the Deaf in Columbus. Wright's Limousine Service will be compensated \$125 per day for each day transportation is provided. This agreement will be in effect from February 2, 2009 through the last day of school for the 2008-2009 school year. The services will be paid through the Special Education IDEA Title VIB grant funds.
- Contracted services between Ohio School Boards Association and the Mansfield Board of Education for a customized training session for Board members. The cost of the training session will not exceed \$900 and will be paid through the Board of Education account.
- Contract services agreement between Visionary Leaders Institute and Mansfield City Schools for consultant presentations aligned to district goals and objectives during the 2008-2009 school year at administrative sponsored professional development sessions. The cost of the services is \$3,500; which will be paid through Title grant funds.
- Contracted services agreement between Solid Video Productions and Mansfield City Schools. Solid Video Productions will create and provide a professional development video library around academic improvement and web links on Improving Teacher Quality during the 2008-2009 school year. The contract will not exceed \$1,500 and will be covered by Title IIA grant funds.
- Articulation agreements between Mansfield City Schools' Career Tech Department and North Central State College's Tech Prep Program for the Interactive Media Program and the CAD (Computer Aided Drafting) Program. The Tech Prep program is

open to students who receive a grade point average of 2.5 or better in the occupational program and an overall high school grade point average of 2.0 or better in their high school program and register into the appropriate associate degree program at NCSC within two years of their high school graduation. There is no cost associated with these agreements.

• A memorandum of understanding between Ohio State University – Mansfield and Mansfield City Schools for the Legacy Scholars Project. The project is to provide fifteen identified seventh grade students with positive academic, personal, and college and career preparation opportunities. Five students will be recruited from each intermediate school (Brinkerhoff, Hedges, and Springmill). Each student must have a "B" average at the end of the 6th grade, they should be first-generation college candidates, the students retains a "B" average through graduation, and have a modest or lower family income. Selected students will attend four 1-hour sessions between February and May, 2009, operated by OSU-M personnel and a mandatory one week academic camp during June 2009. OSU-M will provide financial assistance to support for enrollment into OSU-M for students meeting all the program obligations and completed all eligible financial forms and packages.
