09-185 <u>Resolution to Approve Agreements/Contracts that Benefit the Students</u> of the Mansfield City Schools District

Mrs. Asher moved and Ms. Osgood seconded a resolution to approve the following contract that will directly benefit Mansfield City Schools' students:

- A contract agreement between Dr. Terry Boyd and the Board of Education for training for Board members in Policy Governance. Several training sessions will be held with Board members with each session for 4 to 6 hour periods. Compensation for services, travel, materials, etc. will not exceed \$15,000; which will be paid through the Board of Education account funds.
- Contracted services between e-LocalLink and Mansfield City Schools for e-LocalLink to create a video content or photo montage about Mansfield City Schools for the TygerPride website. The project is in partnership with the City of Mansfield's "Community Movie Program". The cost will not exceed \$5,800 and will be paid through the General Fund.
- Through a contract with Mansfield City Schools, Atlantic Research Partners, LLC will provide nine on-site training sessions in the Power Of Teaching for the district's Building Leadership Teams from September 15, 2009 through April 1, 2010. Consultant fees, materials, and all expenses are included in the fee of \$27,590; which will be paid through Title grants.
- Contracted services between the Mansfield/Ontario/Richland County Health Department and the Mansfield City Schools' Pupil Services Department for physical examinations and consultation services for the 2009-2010 school year. This annual contract will not exceed \$16,600 and will be paid through Special Education grant funds.
- Contracted services between the Mansfield City Schools' Pupil Services Department and the Wright's Full Limousine Service to provide transportation for special needs students who attend the Ohio State School for the Deaf in Columbus. The rate of \$125 per day will be paid through Special Education grant funds.
- Mid-Ohio Education Service Center agrees to provide Mansfield City Schools classroom space, including phone and internet) for the Mansfield City Schools' Special Education Pre-School Program for the 2009-2010 school year at a cost of \$9,000. The cost of the agreement will be paid through Special Education grant funding.
- An educational services agreement between Richland Newhope and the Pupil Services Department for "One-on-One" services for the 2009-2010 school year for various special needs students at a rate of \$11.07 per hour as needed. The cost of this service agreement will be paid through Special Education grant funds.

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- An agreement with The Ohio State University Mansfield Campus to provide jobs for the OSU student participating in the Federal Work-Study Program. There is no cost to the district, participating OSU students are paid through OSU. Students will work an average of 20 hours per week and will not displace current MCS employees.
- An agreement between Mansfield City Schools and U-CAN for the 2009-2010 school year. U-CAN will provide a college access advisor for Mansfield Senior High who will provide hands-on financial aid guidance and career counseling with students. The cost of the program is an annual fee of \$9,000 which will be paid through the Poverty-Based Assistance Grant funding.
