The Mansfield City School District will continue participating in a Free Breakfast and Lunch program for the current school year (2024-2025). This alternative is referred to as the Community Eligibility Provision. Household applications are not required to receive free meals, but applications may be distributed by the school to collect household income data for other programs that require this information.
