OSBA Central Region

Ms. Cline and Mr. Jefferson attended the OSBA Central Region Fall Conference on September 23, 2020. A recording of this performance was played for the board along with a video called "Keepers of the Flame" honoring teachers. Mark Bobo, a consultant from OSBA also greeted the board and offered continued support from the OSBA through this difficult time with the COVID epidemic.

Every Student – Every Day

Ms. Bethany Scott, Principal at Woodland Elementary and K-6 Digital Academy Principal introduced Elizabeth Shirk, as our October Every Student, Every Day Champion. Ms. Shirk is a first grade teacher from our Tyger Digital Academy. Ms. Scott nominated Ms. Shirk because she has embraced the Digital Learning as a 1st grade teacher. She is innovative and engaging with her students and also supports and collaborates with her fellow digital teachers. Ms. Scott stated that Ms. Shirk goes above and beyond with her students and keeps them engaged and interested in this new learning experience. Ms. Shirk introduced two students from her class, Harmony Ash and Joseph Cline who joined our meeting through Google Meet and greeted the board. Ms. Shirk said that both Harmony and Joseph are enthusiastic digital students, always signed on and ready to learn every morning. She thanked both students for signing on and visiting with the board.

Diane Wilkinson Memorial Grant - Reading Program

Dr. Holly Christie, Director of Student Support programs shared the creation of the Diane Wilkinson Memorial Fund through Richland County Foundation. Diane Wilkinson taught for 30 years in the Mansfield City Schools. She taught at Roseland, Carpenter and Springmill. Diane loved all children, but gave of herself even more for those who really needed it. Last year Debbie Stull, a group of teachers and Diane's family met and discussed how they could address the needs of the most vulnerable children in our district with this memorial fund. They decided to create a program at Friendly House where highly qualified teachers, both retired and active, will work with students who are struggling in Reading. Mark Wilkinson joined the meeting and thanked Dr. Christie, his brother and father, and all of those who have worked to create this program in honor of his mother. He agreed that she is looking down on all with gratitude and would be very proud to have her family and friends supporting and helping struggling students.

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<u>Master Teacher Recipient</u> – Kevin Stone, Chairman of the Master Teacher's Committee gave the board an overview of the Master Teacher's program. The MSEA and district formed the committee in 2012 and we have had 13 teachers qualify and receive this certification from ODE since then. Our latest recipient of the Master Teacher Certificate is Lori Nichols. Ms. Nichols is a Student Support Specialist at Prospect Elementary School. Mr. Stone, introduced Ms. Nichols and she stated that she was honored to be approved for this Certificate and to join her fellow Master Teachers who she has a great deal of respect for. She enjoyed the entire experience. Lori thanked the board for this recognition.
