#### Local Report Card Update - Stephen Rizzo, Chief Academic Officer

Mr. Rizzo gave an overview of our Local Report card. While we recognize that we have areas in need of improvement, we are excited about several district-wide successes. We are particularly proud of our Spanish Immersion program, a K-8 school that received 5 out of 5 stars, significantly exceeding state standards in all areas. Sherman Elementary, Springmill STEM, Malabar Intermediate, and the district's Career Technical report card earned 3 stars or more, showing that our students are building a solid foundation for future growth. In addition, Springmill STEM exceeded student growth and gap-closing expectations, and Malabar Intermediate earned a 5, significantly exceeding student growth in the progress component.

The district's overall rating of 2.5 stars reflects specific challenges we are addressing, as outlined in our strategic plan. These include a focus on early literacy and math instruction, reducing chronic absenteeism, and ensuring that all students are ready for their next steps after graduation, whether it be further education, employment, enlistment, or entrepreneurship

#### Superintendent's report:

Mr. Jefferson shared with the board and reviewed the Safety Upgrades that have been put in place for the district. Each month a communication called a monthly digest is emailed to our families. Septembers digest focused on Safety and documented the safety upgrades that have been implemented. They include: Secure Entry Vestibules, Mobile Metal Detectors, Visitor Mgmt. System, Door Prop Alert Systems, Interior and Exterior Security Cameras, Centegix Safety Badges for Staff, Surveillance System linked to MPD, Medical Preparedness, and ongoing trainings and assessments.
