The Kay Day committee, NECIC, Mansfield Police Dept. Mansfield Community Against Violence, the Interdenominational Ministerial Alliance, Restored Vision, RCCS, and We ACT organized this event to honor Kay and to promote the message: "We are here for our Community".

The Mansfield City Schools along RCCS, represented by Community Engagement Specialist, Bridgette Coles, the Mansfield Police Dept., Mayor Theaker, and CACY are joining us to promote the "Peace on my Block" initiative that was approved by the board last month.
