The Mansfield City Schools Board of Education met in a regular session on Monday, November 7, 2022 at 5:30 p.m. in the JoAnn Dutton Community Room at Mansfield Sr. High School. Hoop House - Agribusiness

Mr. Jefferson introduced Mrs. Nikia Fletcher, the Director of College and Career Readiness and she invited the board and audience to follow her to the Mansfield Sr. High Hoop House where Sean Adams, Agribusiness Teacher was waiting to give a presentation. Mr. Adams thanked the board for the opportunity to teach this class and be a part of this exciting program. Mr. Adams pointed out the features of the Hoop House and shared the plants that the current class has planted for this fall. Mr. Adams also shared the partnership they have joined with Kingwood Center and is looking forward to working with them and the community.

Construction Technology – Tiny House

Mrs. Fletcher then introduced Gregory Morris, the Construction Trades Teacher who lead the group to the Construction Trades classroom for a tour and presentation of the current projects that the class is working on. He pointed out the second Book Barn being constructed for the Third Street Family Services location, storage cupboards almost completed for the Golf team, picnic tables for Malabar and then took the tour into the Tiny House to show the new floors and lighting, and the class hopes to have this project finished by the first of the year. Mr. Morris expressed his desire for the class to work on more community projects but stated that transportation continues to be the issue.

The group returned to the boardroom and resumed the regular meeting.

Every Student, Every Day Champion. – Mr. Rizzo introduced Mrs. Fletcher once again to recognize our Every Student, Every Day Champion Gregory Morris, Construction Technology Instructor. Mrs. Fletcher surprised Mr. Morris by telling him that his students were being recognized, which they were, but he was also recognized for his contribution to the program and his dedication to his students. Students Dalton Riley and Chadalyn Whitmore were recognized for building and painting the Tyger Book Barn commissioned by Altrusa International of Mansfield to go outside the First United Methodist Church. They are finishing up another Book Barn to be placed outside the Third Street Family Health Services building.

Altrusa Reading Program – Kelly Holder from Altrusa was present and presented their Early Literacy program to the board. Volunteers from Altrusa will be visiting every first grade classroom in the district once a month from November-April. Volunteers will read the book and the students will get a book to keep. Students will receive 7 books over the course of the year, All of the books for this program are donated by Altrusa.
