STEM Honors Diploma – William Payne

One of the requirements to earn a STEM Honors Diploma is to give a presentation to the Board. William Payne presented the process and requirements that he has followed to earn his STEM Honors Diploma. High-level coursework, college and career readiness tests, and real-world experiences were some of the challenges that he met. William began earning high school credit as a 7th grader and started taking CCP classes as a freshman. He will earn his associate's degree from OSU in the spring and is on track to earn up to 8 graduation seals.

Update on Malabar Care Connect – Third St. Clinic

Dr. Holly Christy shared with the board that Third Street Family Health Services has applied and was awarded a grant from Ohio Department of Health to expand the current services at Malabar Care Connect. The school-based clinic will now be available to more students in the district. Some of the additional services are: telehealth services to the Middle and High School, dental care, vaccinations, and continue and expand services with the current Community Health Workers. Mansfield City Schools received \$114,000 for facility upgrades to the clinic. The upgrades include creating an exterior door to the clinic so it is accessible to patients when schools are closed.
