Board Member Comments:

Superintendent's Report:

Saturday, July 15th I attended the 3rd annual Kay Day Peace March. This march is an event created by a group of local organizations to honor the former NECIC community organizer Geneva "Kay" Smith who passed in 2019. Kay was a former student and a Tyger athlete, actively involved in her school and community. As an adult Kay was an anti-violence advocate and community organizer.

The Kay Day committee, NECIC, Mansfield Police Dept. Mansfield Community Against Violence, the Interdenominational Ministerial Alliance, Restored Vision, RCCS, and We ACT organized this event to honor Kay and to promote the message: " We are here for our Community".

The Mansfield City Schools along RCCS, represented by Community Engagement Specialist, Bridgette Coles, the Mansfield Police Dept., Mayor Theaker, and CACY are joining us to promote the "Peace on my Block" initiative that was approved by the board last month. We are encouraging our students and families to take the Peace on My Block pledge to end the violence in our community.

This evening we were scheduled to attend the City Council meeting and present the "Peace on my Block" pledge and initiative. We were asked to reschedule due to a heavy agenda. We will present to City Council in the near future. Wednesday morning we will present the same to the Richland County Chamber of Commerce.
