## Presentations:

Every Student, Every Day Champion: Mr. Rizzo introduced Ms. Jennifer Davis, 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Teacher at Woodland Elementary as our Champion for the month of September. Ms. Chris Queen, fellow teacher at Woodland nominated Ms. Davis and she shared with the board that Jennifer is an exceptional teacher that personifies a constant positive attitude, leads and works well with her peers and always puts the students in her class first. Mr. Rizzo also recognized Bre'Ale Harvey, a second grader from Woodland Elementary, who shares Ms. Uhde's positive attitude and is always willing to help others in her class. Mr. Winston Greene recognized Colin Kitzler who scored a perfect score on the OST Grade 6 Test. This is the second perfect score that Colin has achieved on our State Tests. Colin is a 7<sup>th</sup> Grader at Spanish Immersion. Our final student champion was Niall Cavanaugh, a 3<sup>rd</sup> grader at Malabar who represented Woodland Elementary this summer in the Pinewood Derby.

## Open Door Academy:

Dr. Holly Christie introduced Dr. Dorothy Moulthrop and Mark Notz from the Open Door Academy. Dr. Moulthrop and Mr. Notz have met with the Superintendent, Dr. Christie, Mr. Rizzo and Mr. Hager over the summer to develop this new after-school program at Malabar for 3<sup>rd</sup>. and 6<sup>th</sup> graders. This is a grant funded program that provides several activities for students 3 days a week. Today was the first day of the program and it was great success. Mr. Link Briggs who has organized the program at the building level and Mr. Chris Hershberger of Blackbelt Fitness shared that today's sessions went very well and they are encouraged with the turnout and enthusiasm of the students.

## Local Report Card Report:

Stephen Rizzo, Chief Academic Officer for Mansfield City Schools, provided an overview of the 2021-2022 District and School Local Report Cards. The report cards, which are released annually by the Ohio Department of Education, have been revised with a new format and are now based on a star rating system. Due to the pandemic, ratings were not released the last 2 years. Points of progress, school highlights, and areas of focus were shared.
