



His desire for education was so great he read many scientific books At I5, he was printing and editing a small paper of his own. He learned telegraphy and in 1864 invented an automatic telegraph repeater. During the next few years he devised stock tickers, telegraph systems and the electri pen which developed into the mimiograph. He established a manufactturing plant at Newark N.J. which he gave up afterward in order to devote himself wholly to invention. In 1877, Edison made application for a patent on a phonograph or speaking machine, Edison has taken out more than I000 patents besides having originated hundreds of minor device


Among the most notable of his achievements are the phonograph. the incandescant electric lamp, long distance transmission telephone, megaphone, aerophone, dupnickeliron storage cell. These a many others are the inventions given to us by Thomas A. Edisen.
