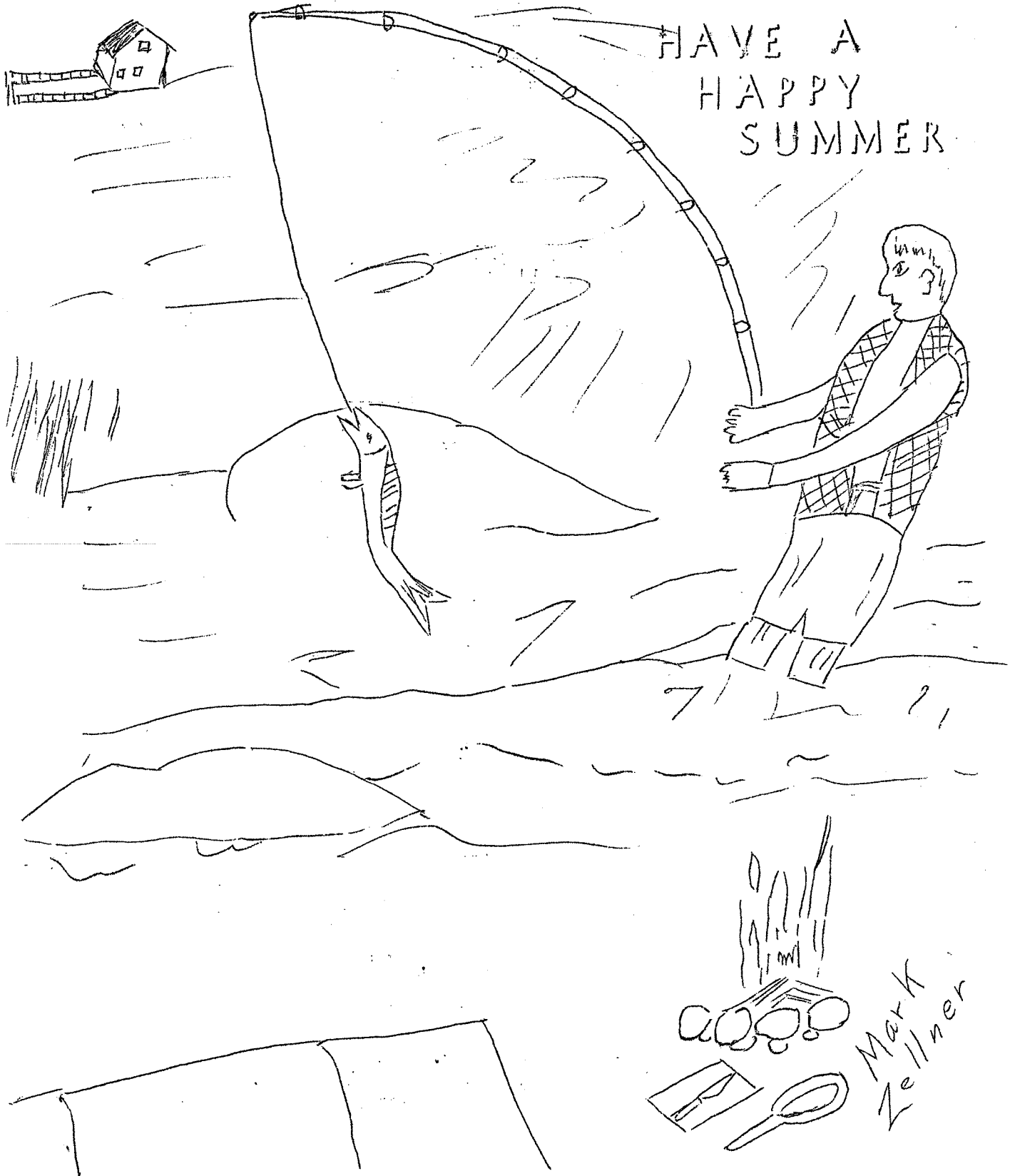

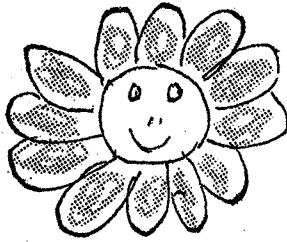

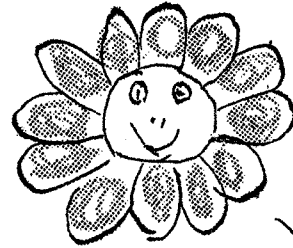

Third prize-Jimmy Davis, Donna Goad and Lisa Burton.

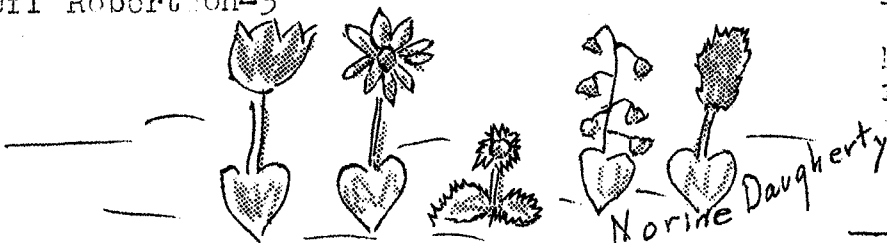

I have two pets. One is a kitten, her name is Pansy. She is part Siamese and part Persian Blue.

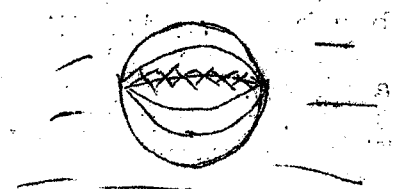
Bootsie is my other cat. She is a big cat. Her nickname is Big Cat.

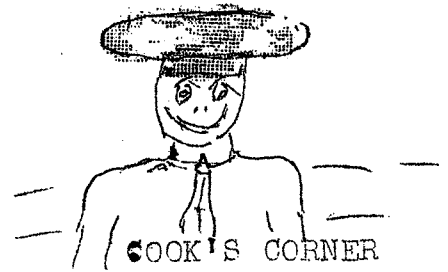
## THE SCHOOL BAND

### Chocolate Cream Squares

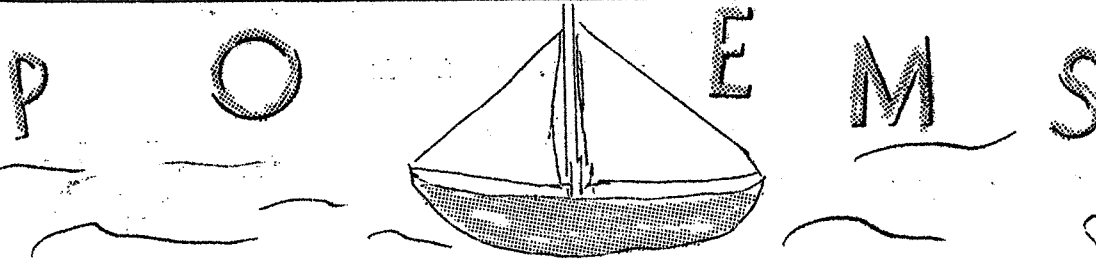
## A TORNADO IN XENIA

I like to weave. Everybody likes to weave and it is pretty. After you finish it you can cut it off the box.

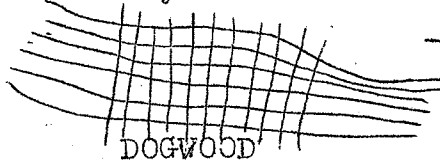
