## SCIENCE

### How Plants Make And Use Their Food

The green part of most plants is one of the most important things in nature. It is called chlorophyll, a name that means light green leaf. This chlorophyll may be found not only in leaves but in stems and flowers as well. If the sun falls on it and the temperature is right, chlorophyll can combine water and carbon dioxide to start a reaction that makes starches and sugars. For the most part the plants get the carbon dioxide from the air. They usually get the water through the roots from the ground, though this is not always true. The carbon dioxide is freed into the air by the breathing of animals, by fires, decay of things and even by some plants themselves. In combining this gas with water, the plant gives off some oxygen that is useful to all of us and the animals.

## PEANUT BUTTER TREATS

- 1 cup white Karo syrup or honey
- 1 cup Peanut Butter
- $1\frac{1}{2}$  cup Dry Milk
- 1 cup Confectioner sugar
