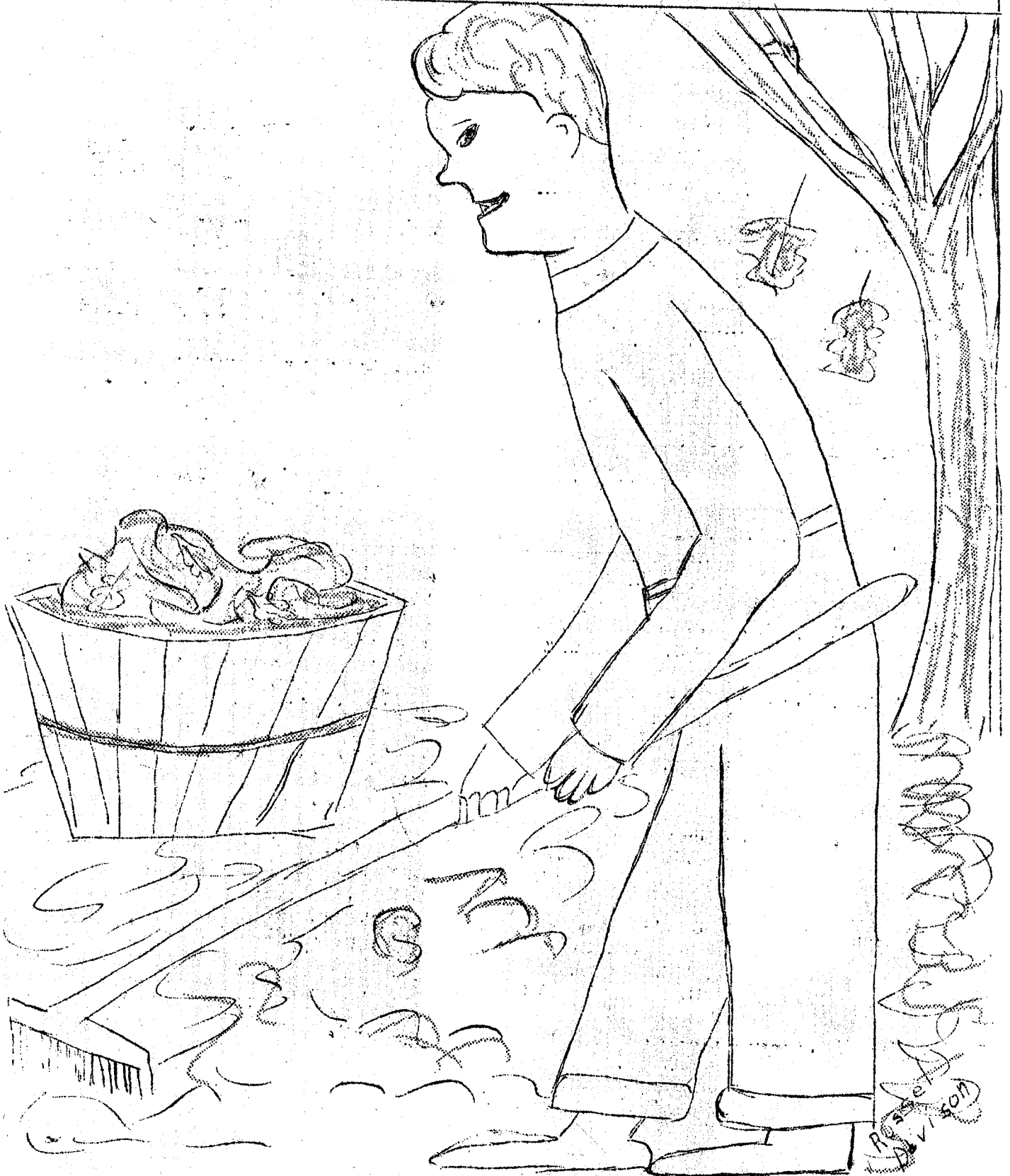


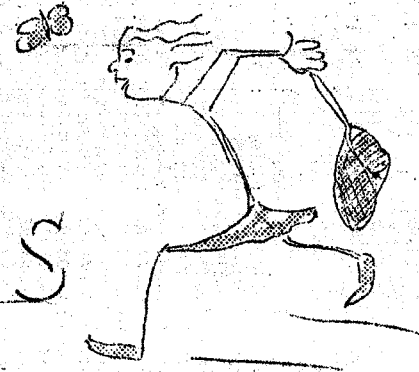

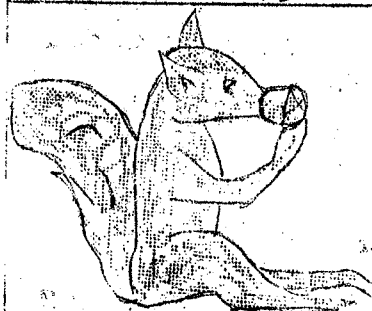

FIRE DRILLS AND PLAY GROUND SAFETY

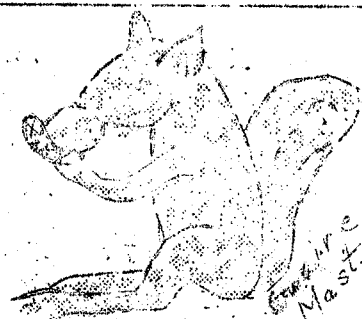

The money from the sale of tickets will help to buy uniforms for the grade school football teams.

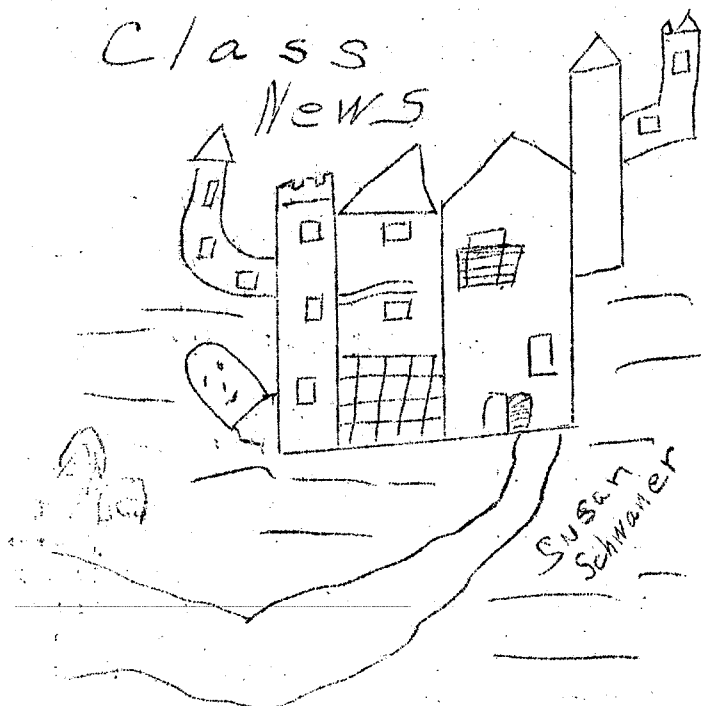

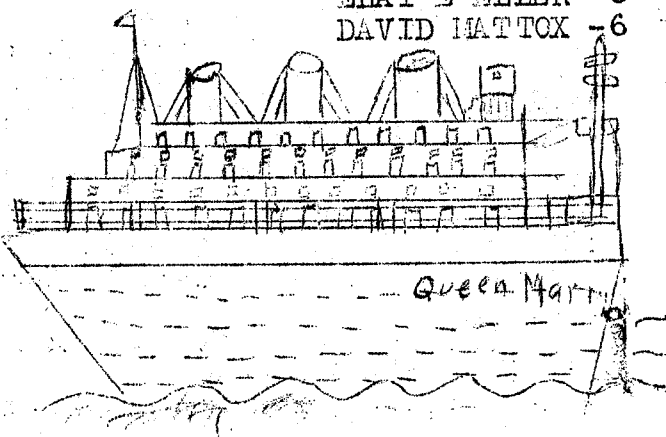
MISS ERVIN'S ROOM

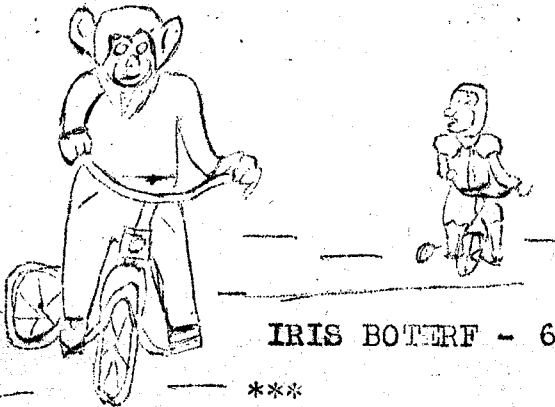

The Way I Got My Puppy

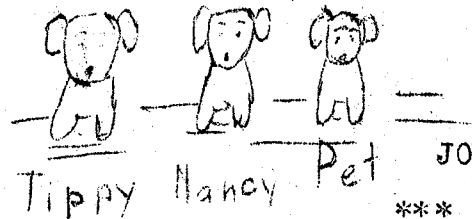
One night when we were coming home from a fair Mother saw something shinning on the road. She had to stop quickly.

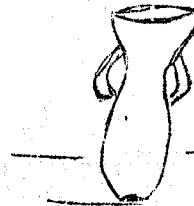

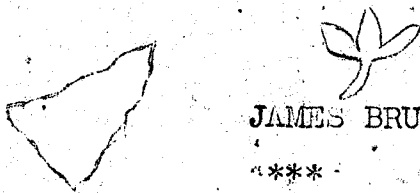
Our Pictures
