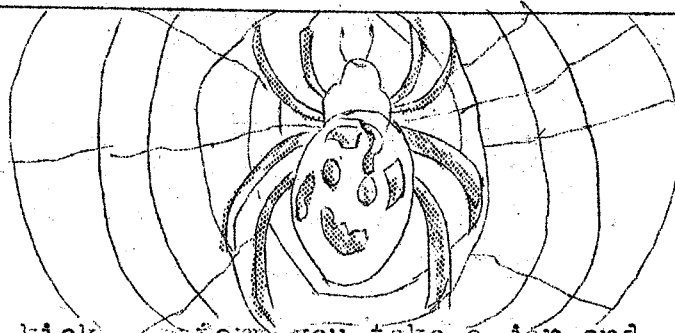
#### FUNGUS

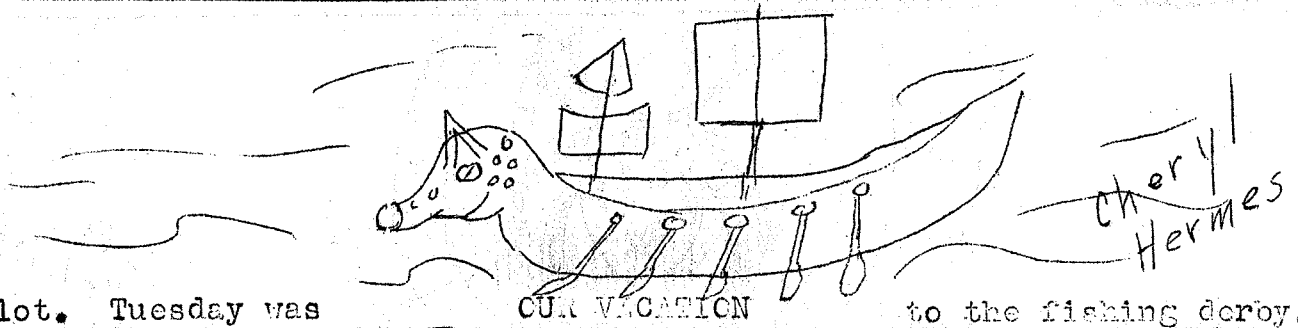

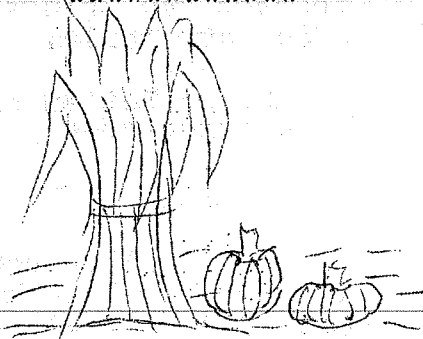
EXPERIMENTS

1/2 teaspoon vanilla  
1/2 cup butter or margarine  
1 cup sugar  
2 eggs, well beaten  
2 t. baking powder  
Sift flour once, measure, add baking powder and salt, and sift again. Cream butter, add sugar gradually, and cream together until light and fluffy. Add eggs and beat well. Add vanilla: blend. Add flour, a small amount at a time, beating after each addition until smooth. Chill the batter until

it's firm enough to roll. Roll dough 1/8" thick on a lightly floured board and cut with 2 1/4 inches round cookie cutter. Put on an ungreased baking sheet and bake in a hot oven (400°F.) for 8 to 10 minutes, or until edges are lightly browned. This recipe makes about 8 dozen cookies.
