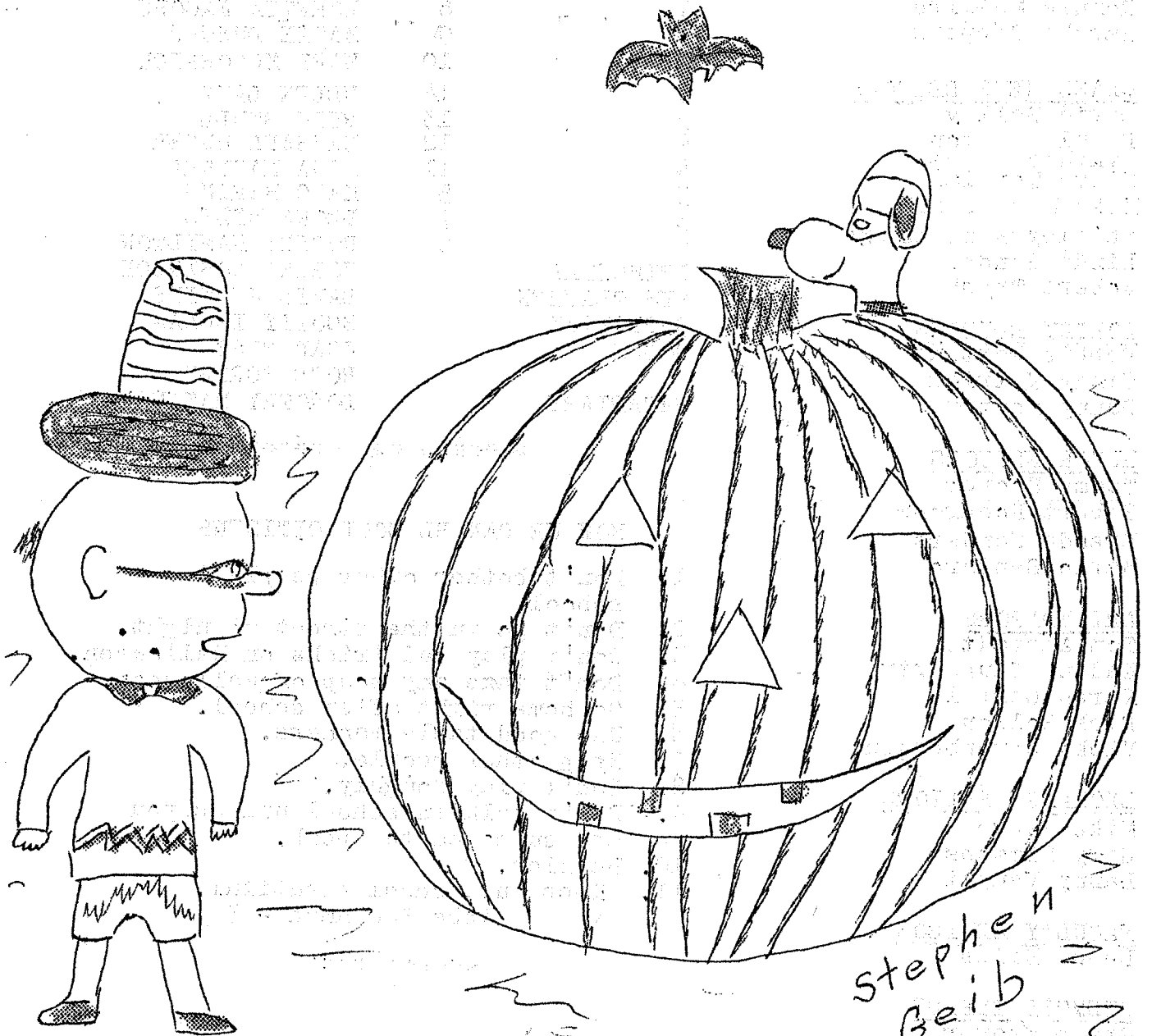

November 12, 1968, there will be a P.T.A. meeting. Herman Baughman, Elementary Guidance Counselor, will be the speaker.

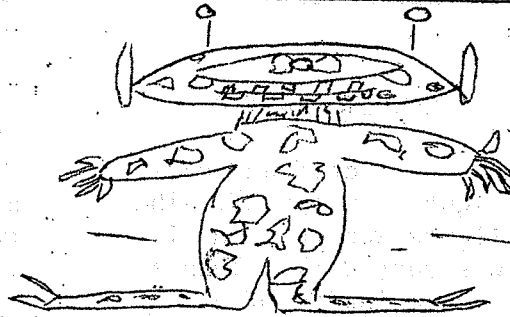

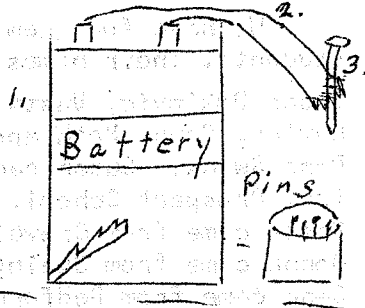

Please follow these rules. If you do, your holiday will be an exciting one. Have fun!

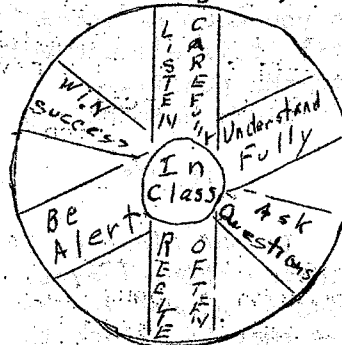

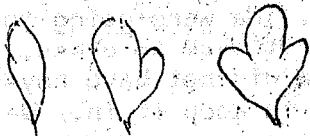

Place the buns on a cooky sheet. Slip an egg in the hole. Season. Bake in slow oven (325°) for 25 minutes.

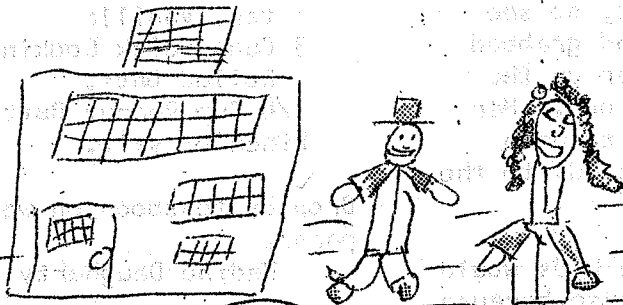
Top the bun and the egg with a slice of cheese. Bake until the cheese puffs, about 5 minutes.
