- There is a \$10 charge for each children's vaccine • There is no charge if unable to pay.
- Children must be accompanied by a parent/legal guardian or another adult with written permission from the parent.
- The Health Department participates in the federally-funded "Vaccines For Children" program.
- Neighborhood Clinics are funded by local tax levy dollars and grants from the Ohio Department of Health.
- Adult vaccine available (costs will vary by vaccine): Tetanus, Tdap and Pneumonia. Other adult vaccine if pre-arranged.
